Standing Firm in Faith

TODAY'S SCRIPTURE (KJV)

Hebrews 10:23

"Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)"

KEY TRUTH

We stand firm because our confidence rests in God's faithfulness, not our own strength.

GOOD MORNING!

Good morning! Faith is tested whenever pressure tries to move us away from what God has said.

Standing firm does not mean that we never feel weak or uncertain. It means that we refuse to abandon the truth when feelings and circumstances begin to change.

The writer of Hebrews directs our attention to the faithfulness of the One who promised. Our stability comes from God's unchanging character. He has never failed, forgotten, or broken His Word.

Plant your feet upon Scripture today. When doubt speaks, answer with truth. When fear pushes, hold your ground. God is faithful, and His promises are strong enough to support you.

- 3 Reject one fear that contradicts God's Word.
