TODAY'S SCRIPTURE (KJV)

Hebrews 10:24-25

"And let us consider one another to
provoke unto love and to good works:
Not forsaking the assembling of
ourselves together."

KEY TRUTH

**God strengthens believers
through the encouragement and
fellowship of His people.**

GOOD MORNING!

Standing firm was never intended to be a solitary assignment. God places believers within a church family so that faith can be strengthened through fellowship.

Isolation magnifies discouragement. Encouragement reminds us that we are not alone, that others are praying, and that God is still working.

The writer of Hebrews tells us to consider one another.

Encouragement should be intentional. Notice who is missing, who is quiet, who is carrying a burden, and who needs to hear that their faithfulness matters.

Do not only ask who will encourage you. Ask whom God wants you to strengthen. A phone call, prayer, visit, or sincere word may help someone continue standing.

TAKE FIVE CHALLENGE

Take five intentional minutes today.

- 1 **Read Hebrews 10:24-25.**
- 2 **Identify someone who needs encouragement.**
- 3 **Contact that person today.**
- 4 **Spend five minutes praying for your church family.**
- 5 **Prepare your heart to worship with others.**
