TODAY'S SCRIPTURE (KJV)

1 Corinthians 15:58

"Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord."

KEY TRUTH

Because Christ is victorious, faithful service is never empty, forgotten, or wasted.
