TODAY'S SCRIPTURE (KJV)

2 Peter 3:18

"But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ."

KEY TRUTH

Spiritual growth is the lifelong process of becoming more like Jesus through grace.

GOOD MORNING!

A new life is meant to grow. Just as physical life requires nourishment, spiritual life develops through God's Word, prayer, worship, fellowship, and obedience.

Growth is not always dramatic. Often it happens quietly as God reshapes our reactions, deepens our understanding, and teaches us to trust Him in ordinary moments.

Do not become discouraged because you have not arrived. Look for evidence of grace. Are you quicker to forgive, more willing to serve, or more sensitive to God's voice? Thank Him for every step.

Stay rooted in Christ. Healthy growth is not produced by pressure to impress others, but by remaining close to the Savior who supplies everything you need.
